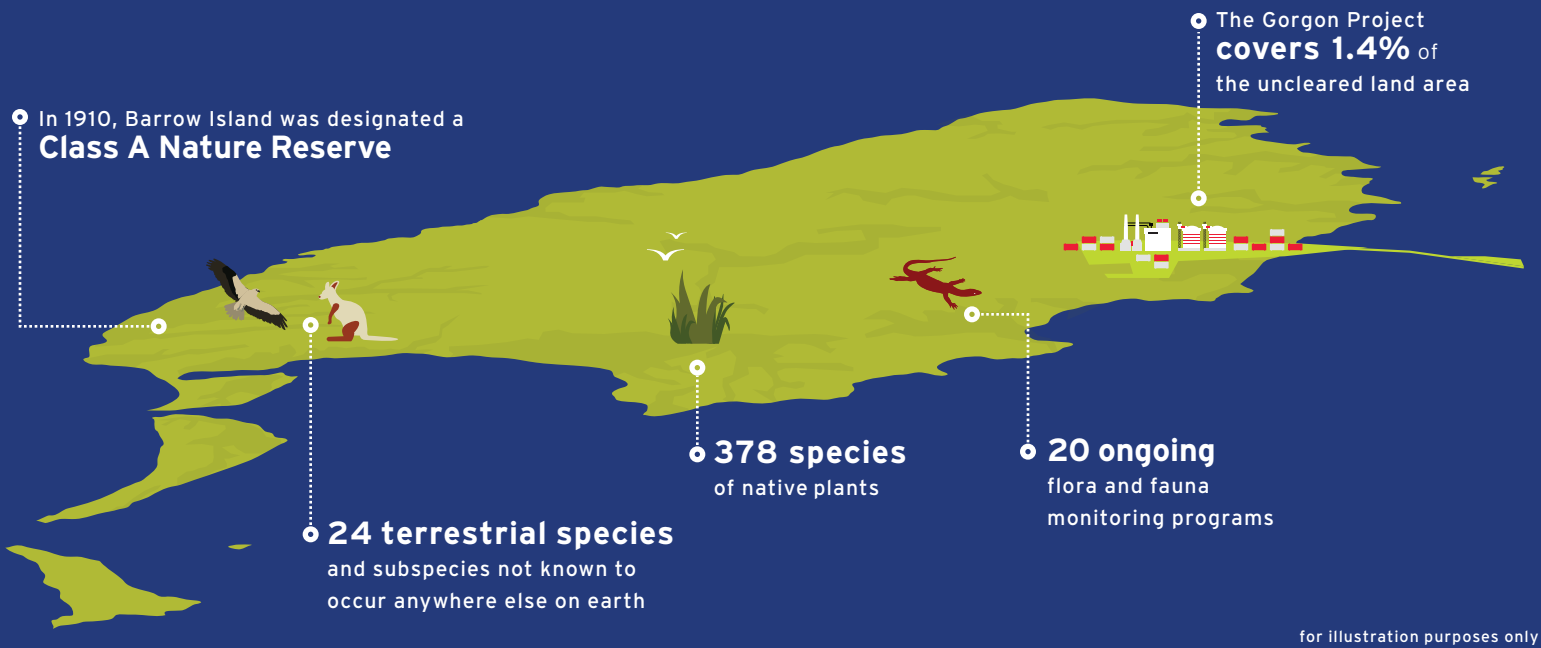


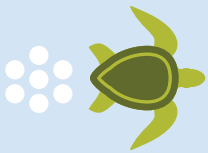
DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP ON BARROW ISLAND

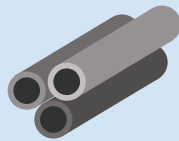


Environmental Innovation to Conserve Biodiversity
