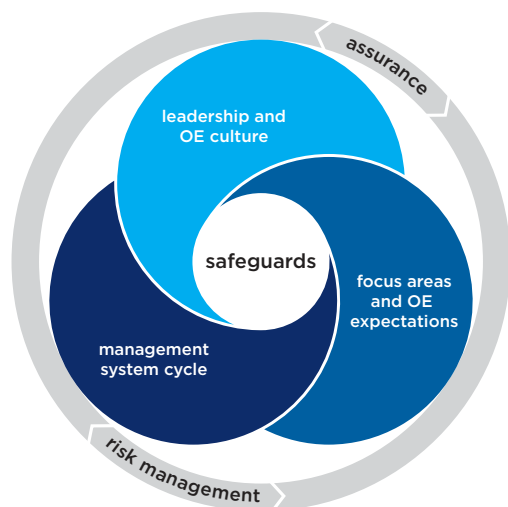


Operational Excellence (OE)
